Schedule for Oral Examination and Certificate Verification Second Phase for M.Phil (Part-Time) / Ph.D. (Part-Time) Admissions

The candidates applied for M.Phil. / Ph.D. (Part-Time) of AURCET-2017 and appeared for written examination conducted during 16-17 Aug, 2017 are hereby directed to attend for the oral examination and certificate verification (with Hall-Ticket of AURCET-2017) as per the schedule and list enclosed.

All the candidates are advised to verify their eligibility criteria for M.Phil. (Part-Time) / Ph.D. (Part-Time) admissions in the departments they have applied for, before attending the oral examination / certificate verification.

Oral examination will be conducted in the concerned Departments and Certificate Verification will be conducted at the office of the Director, Directorate of Admissions, Andhra University, Vijayanagar Palace, Pedawaltair, Visakhapatnam only.

Candidates who are absent for oral examination will not be considered for admission.

The candidates should bring all the relevant Original Certificates and Documents as listed below:

1. Hall Ticket of AURCET-2017.
2. Provisional or original Certificate and marks statements of qualifying examination. Candidates are expected to submit the consolidated statement of marks.
3. Candidates with qualifying degrees from the Universities outside Andhra Pradesh have to produce equivalency certificate from Andhra University.
4. Original Certificate of M.Phil degree, UGC-CSIR NET/ICMR (Lecturer ship), APSET in the concerned subject (if applicable).
5. Transfer certificate from the institution where last studied.
6. Integrated Community Certificate issued by the competent authority in case of **SC/ST/BC** candidates.
7. Latest Income Certificate issued by the competent authority (valid for 4 years) or white ration card in case of eligible SC/ST/BC/EBC candidates claiming fee concession (for Full-Time).
8. Migration certificate in case of candidates from other Universities.
9. Date of birth certificate (S.S.C. / Matriculation / Equivalent Certificate).
10. Study Certificates from issued by the Heads of the respective institutes at least 7 years ending with qualifying examination.
11. Residence certificate for 10 years in case of private study only.
12. Physical Fitness Certificate from the Medical Officer, Andhra University or from a Govt. Assistant Civil Surgeon.
13. Service certificates (for Part-Time) from organization.
14. No objection certificate (for Part-Time) from present organization.
15. Two sets of attested copies of all the above certificates/documents.

The candidates have to pay in cash at the counter arranged at the venue, a counseling fee of Rs.1000/- (Rs.500/- for all eligible SC/ST/PWD candidates). Bank commission is extra.
